Prayer & Financial Support

A summer staff position with Shamineau Ministries is a training experience in ministry and missions. As part of this training, we require each staff member to send at least 15 support letters requesting both prayers and financial support for their ministry prior to their arrival at staff training. Our main desire is for each specific staff person, the staff as a whole, the Camp and the campers to be upheld in prayer throughout the summer. Donated funds will be used to support the ministries of Shamineau. For paid positions, pay is not contingent on the amount of financial support raised. Each staff person will be required to turn in the names and addresses of those who received request letters as well as a copy of the letter. SWAT Team participants and WIT program participants will not be required to send support letters. The cost for participation in the SWAT and WIT programs is \$50/week.

- Enter into their job responsibilities and staff relationships with a positive and supportive attitude.
- Sacrifice personal desires in the interest of campers and peers.
- Make decisions regarding relationships, entertainment, dress and conduct in a manner that would honor the body of Christ.
- Completely abstain from the use of tobacco products, illicit drugs, and the drinking of alcohol on and off the camp property.
