Trail Guide

Guides will facilitate groups of up to eight people on both weeklong canoe trips and weeklong adventure camps. Canoe trips take place in the Boundary Waters. Adventure Camp is a week at base camp, doing day adventures canoeing, rock climbing, high ropes, hiking and more.

*Minimum age is 19

Base Camp / Maintenance

This position will assist the director in base camp maintenance and other responsibilities, including transporting groups, mowing, maintaining cabins, cutting wood, programming, high ropes, rock climbing, etc.

*Minimum age is 18

Kitchen Supervisor

This person will be responsible for making meals for in-base groups, managing the kitchen and cleanup, making and dehydrating food for canoe trips, and managing inventory. Will also have the chance to help with programming and other base camp activities.

*Minimum age is 18

Guide In Training (GIT)

(Ages 15 – 19)

GIT's get to experience 4 weeks of amazingness. Week one is spent with the other GIT's on a weeklong canoe trip. You will then spend two weeks of serving at base camp, cleaning cabins, helping in the kitchen, helping with maintenance work, programming, etc. Your fourth week will be spent co-guiding either a canoe trip or a week of adventure camp with one of the trail guides. Weeks 2-4 are in no particular order. The fee for participation is \$249 per session and includes room, board, meals and canoe trip. Please check the session you would like to work. If you would like, you may rate the sessions in order to indicate preferences.
