Thank you for considering bringing your youth group or organization to Rock Ridge Christian Camp & Outfitters to experience Adventure Camp. We are passionate about taking youth into the wilderness to be challenged physically, mentally and spiritually. Our 55-acre camp is located on the shores of Little Long Lake in northern Minnesota, creating a perfect setting for sharing the ways of Jesus Christ.

Adventure Camp provides a new adventure each day, including canoeing, hiking, rock climbing, river tubing, dog scootering (riding an all-terrain scooter being pulled by an Alaskan husky), high ropes course, ziplining, fishing, night games and so much more. Stay in a cabin each night and eat hot meals from the dining hall for breakfasts and suppers. Cabins experience separate adventures each day, but come together for chapel and games in the evening. Lunch is typically on trail, and you do have the option to spend a night or two camping while doing your canoe portion. Everything is planned ahead of time and prepared for you, so that when you show up, you can focus on being relational with your youth and not having to worry about anything else.

We hire a number of trail guides each year that go through two weeks of extensive guide training. They are trained in first aid and CPR, camp cooking, route planning, orienteering, working with today's youth, ministry preparation, federal and state regulations, rock climbing, high ropes training and so much more. When completed, they are ready and excited to serve you. Phone calls are set up before your arrival to discuss Adventure Camp with your guide, the ministry content that you would like prepared and any little things that need to be discussed beforehand, such as allergies, disabilities or medical conditions within your group.

Adventure Camp Rates and Available Dates

Each cabin can consist of up to 7 youth and 1 adult. More adults and less youth are okay, as long as you come with at least one adult per group. We are very intentional in our ministry about your youth experiencing a life-changing trip with your leader, so that leaders can go back home and build upon that change. Rock Ridge can cater up to 6 cabins per week. Each cabin goes on a different adventure during the day, but comes together for chapel and games in the evenings. Our weeks run from Saturday through Friday and are listed below:
