## WHAT TIME DO WE ARRIVE? WHAT TIME ARE WE DONE ON SUNDAYS?

**Check-in: Friday from 6:00pm (SHUTTLE LEAVES AT 6:30pm)**  
**Check-out: Sunday late morning**

\*Be sure to eat supper before you come!

Check in is at 6:00 PM on Friday night and we will begin to shuttle out to the Island around 6:30 PM. Check-out will be after closing chapel. No lunch will be served on Sunday.

## WHAT ARE THE SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS? WILL I BE HOUSED WITH PEOPLE I DON'T KNOW?



Dads and sons are housed together in the same cabin with other sons of similar age and their dads. If you are coming with a group of dads and sons you will be housed together.

Dads and daughters & mothers and sons are NOT housed together in the same cabin. The parent will be housed with other parents and the child will be housed with other children with a same gender staff member as a camp counselor.

\*If coming with a group be sure to indicate that when you register.

Our Island Cabins are on a slab, real roof and door with screened walls that have canvas flaps. There is no electricity in the cabins. Campers sleep on bunk beds and there are 5 bunks in each cabin. The Island also has a lodge which does include electricity and refrigeration. The lodge is also the storm shelter.
