## WHAT TIME DO WE ARRIVE? WHAT TIME ARE WE DONE ON CLOSING DAY?

**Check-in: Friday from 5:30-7:30pm**

**Check-out: Sunday at 12:00pm (Weekend #1 - Monday at 12:00pm)**

Check-in will be on the road as you arrive. You will receive your housing assignment and schedule for the weekend. If you know you are arriving late, please call in advance.

Check-out will be after closing chapel. No lunch will be served on closing day.

## WHAT ARE THE SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS? WILL I BE HOUSED WITH PEOPLE I DON'T KNOW?

Each family has their own housing.

If you are in one of our retreat centers you will have your own sleeping room with the bathrooms just a short walk down the hallway. If you are in one of the cabins you get the whole cabin to yourselves no matter what size your family is, and the bathrooms are in a building just a short walk away. We have a variety of buildings that house our guests. Our retreat centers have sleeping rooms that each typically have 3 sets of bunks in them. Our cabins have 6 sets of bunks.
