FAQ'S

How many churches attend a typical weekend?

A typical weekend will have about 350-550 students. There will be between 10-15 churches coming for the weekend, depending on the size of their youth group. We have had some groups that are quite small (4-6 students) and other groups that are quite large (100 students).

All weekends are open to both Middle and High School groups.

What is included in the cost? How does payment work?

The registration fee includes housing, meals, and ALL activities. You only pay for the people you bring. If you are certain of your payment, you can bring a check with you at check-in or we can bill you after your weekend for accuracy of payment due. We prefer checks rather than credit cards to avoid cc fees. We ask that you collect payment from students for the weekend and provide one check to cover your group.

What is chapel like during the weekend?

Chapel times include games, music led by a worship band, and a teaching time with a Gospel-focused speaker specifically chosen for his/her ability to communicate with students.

Will my group have any time to ourselves?

Throughout the day, you'll have plenty of chances to engage one-on-one with students during open recreation and various activities. Additionally, following each chapel session, dedicated breakout time will be set aside for you and your group to discuss the sessions message.

Can I bring my baby or child with to the retreat??

We kindly ask that youth leaders do not bring babies or children along for the weekend. Unfortunately, we don't have housing options that can accommodate families, and the retreat schedule is full and not well suited for little ones. We want leaders to be fully engaged with their students throughout the weekend, and we've found this works best when all leaders are able to focus completely on their group.
